Top Ten Native Plant Recommendations from Kerry Wixted, Maryland DNR

White oak (Quercus alba)- large tree Supports 462 species of caterpillars plus birds and small and large mammals





Serviceberry (Amelanchier spp.)- small tree/shrub Supports pollinators, birds and mammals





Trumpet or coral honeysuckle (Lonicera sempervirens)- vine Nectar and pollen for hummingbirds, bees, butterflies Berries for birds, Leaves for deer



Milkweed -Butterflyweed (Asclepias tuberosa), Swamp milkweed (Asclepias incarnata) and Common milkweed flowers (Asclepias syriaca) -Monarch host plant, nectar







Goldenrod (Solidago spp.)- flower; note: some goldenrods can be aggressive (which means they fill in areas quickly and cheaply but need to be managed); zig-zag goldenrod and bluestemmed goldenrod are shade species that behave Supports 125 species of moths/butterflies



Red maple (Acer rubrum)- small tree Supports 276 moths/butterflies plus birds and small and large mammals





Viburnum (Viburnum spp.)**- shrub; caveatplant native and be careful with viburnum leaf beetle; high wildlife value but may require maintenance; maple-leaved viburnum is short and cherry-leaved viburnum is tall



Golden ragwort (Packera aurea)groundcover Provides nectar for small bees, butterflies and moths, groundcover for fireflies



Mountain mint (Pycnanthemeum spp.)-flower Attractive to many species of pollinators



Asters- white wood aster (shade) larval host plant, seeds for birds and mammals, **NY aster** (fall bloomer) supports fall pollinators, seeds for birds, small mammals, larval host for Pearl Crescent Butterfly

Organic plants? Otherwise, always ask the buyer! Workers may not know.
